Snakes

We encourage you to pay through the Book a Court web site, so that there is an official record of your payment. The official record allows you to book a court.

If you pay through the bank please sent an email to the club Treasurer

(treasure@majuratennis.com.au.) so your registration can be recorded on Book a Court. Some damage has been done to court 2. We believe the damage was done by a cockatoo or a similar bird. We now have a collection of small black pipes which to put on the courts to deter birds from damaging the courts. There are sufficient "snakes" to put 4 on each end of each court.

We would ask you to put the "snakes" back on the courts after you have completed your tennis.

Bagging the Courts

In order to keep the courts in good condition we need to "bag" the courts regularly to ensure an even spread of the sand. We would ask you to "bag" the courts at the end of your tennis session.

What do if the Gate Code does not work after you have booked.

Remember that it takes a few minutes for the booking to be processed by book a court. Moreover, you need to enter your pin close to the beginning of your booking. If you booking has been processed and you still cannot access the courts please contact the President or the Secretary and they will be able to assist you.
